#### 2. Guest Speakers

- a. Dave Cortese- County update (10 mins) State of the County address he stated the county was going to conduct a health assessment of children throughout the year. There is a push around the Bay Area to ensure there is information for securing grants for public health. There have been ethnic based reports in African American community and Hispanic/Latino community. There is a new children health assessment across Santa Clara County. Public Health Department will be conducting surveys throughout the communities in Santa Clara County.  
Since the economic recession they county is doing well and is overcoming lots of the losses since its cuts to bargaining units in the county.  
Abode is working with individuals who are homeless and are working together with non-profits in Santa Clara County called social impact bonds. This Pay for Success is funding for homelessness issues. There was a audit on homelessness issues in Santa Clara County and found out there is a 521 million dollar deficit The county is working on a joint venture program to help house homeless people.
- b. Sandi Randels (20 mins) San Jose Evergreen Community College District is a basic tax district that keeps its funding from local property taxes. 7% of local property taxes goes directly to the SJECCD any additional bonds issues within the district community members need to pay out of pocket Much of the land will be locked into a 90 year land use deal. SJECCD approved the land deal prior to updating the EVS Master Plan for the college long term outlook. The community has asked the SJECCD to be provided with a copy of the 27 acre land appraisal. There was a study to find out how many students from the SJECCD District attend de Anza and West Valley and over 18,500  
A majority of the 8 excess basic funding colleges offer more degrees and certificates than SJECCD does.
