1. Call to order
2. SJPD Report – Lt. Guittierez
 - a. District Paul (Evergreen/East San Jose) Statistics for last month were similar to prior
 - i. 32 aggravated assaults
 - ii. 9 robberies
 - iii. 16 strong-armed robberies
 - iv. 28 burglaries
 - v. 3 car jackings
 - b. Highest activities are King/Tully and Quimby/White on Thursdays and Saturdays between 10:00AM and noon.
3. 2019 Steering Committee Elections
 - a. The slate of candidates for 2019 Steering Committee was announced
 - i. President – Pat Waite
 - ii. Vice President – Burton Smith
 - iii. Treasurer – Steve Bennette
 - iv. Secretary – Jeremy Barousse
 - v. Members at Large – Sherry Gilmore, Daniel Gould, Marilyn Leonard
 - b. As there were no nominations from the floor, the slate was deemed passed
 - c. Bonnie Mace complimented the existing board, noting that the lack of additional nominations indicates that the members believe the current leadership is doing a good job.
4. Council Office Report – Patrick McGarrity
 - a. SJPD has added 200 officers over the past two years
 - b. The councilmember is working with business owners at Quimby and White to organize them to make the area more secure and safer.
 - c. Funds from Measures B and T will start to flow soon
 - i. Major arterials are on an 8 year maintenance cycle
 - ii. Neighborhoods are being done in “clumps” starting with the worst rated roads
 - iii. Direct questions, concerns and comments on roads to Matt Savage, who is the Councilmember’s transportation person
 - iv. Eastridge light rail to BART is moving into planning, with EIR being finalized.
5. Local history – Alan Leventhal, SJSU Anthropology Department
 - a. Mr. Leventhal gave an engaging and enthusiastic presentation on the prehistory and tribal heritage of the Muwekma Ohlone Tribe
